









Structure of The Training

The training combined with the previous Evolvia undergraduate education, is a total of 128 hours ICF Accredited Coaching Education Level 2.

This covers the base study hours for PCC certification levels. Performance Evaluation for ACC and PCC are included.

Online Training

The program begins March 6th 2025 with weekly online classes on Thursdays at 5:30 to 7:30pm GMT.

Online classes will run for 10 weeks before France, and 8 weeks after. The last session will be on July 10th.

PCC Markers Training

Advanced Coach Training includes advanced studies in the ICF Core Competencies and PCC Markers to prepare students for PCC evaluation.

PCC Performance Evaluation

Each student will receive a private session to polish their core coaching competencies for a PCC level. Each student will receive feedback on recordings for PCC performance Evaluations.

Written Feedback

Students will practice giving and receiving feedback on their coaching, and will receive several written feedback forms from trainers aiming to improve their coaching skills.



MCC Sessions

10 recorded sessions of MCC coaching will be available to learn from and study.

Recordings

Recordings of online classes are available for one year as a source for reviewing and upgrading skills.

Homework

Make sure you allocate at least 2-4 hours each week for practicing and studying.

Training at Château Garreau
